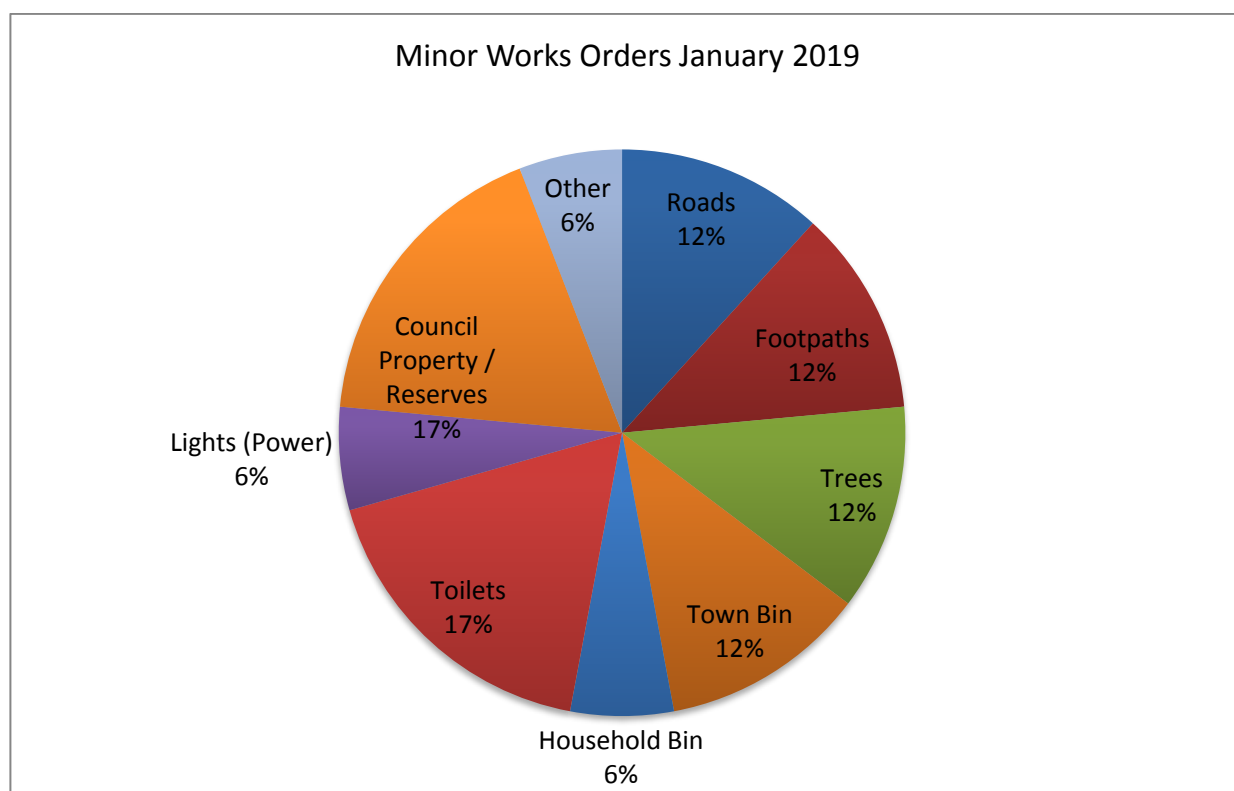

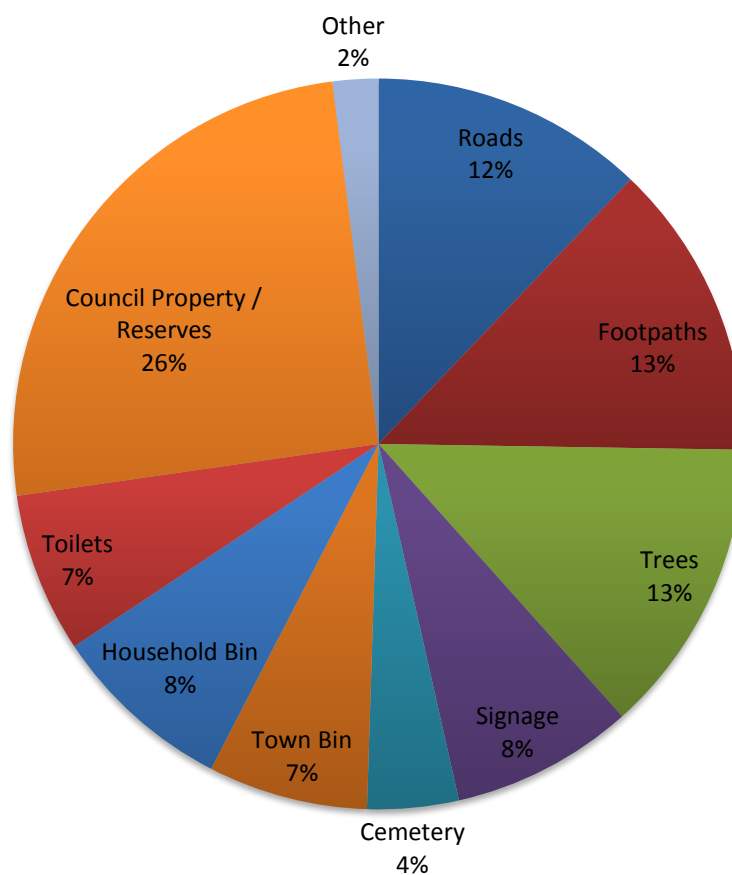

7.4 DROUGHT COMMUNITIES PROGRAMME

Council has received confirmation of funding through the Drought Communities Programme for the Tourism Related Road Re-sheeting Project of \$285,000.

The objectives of the project are:

- Re-sheeting of unsealed roads particularly focussing on higher use roads and tourist routes
- Installing or replacing tourism signage on upgraded roads where necessary
- Installing a tourist picnic shelter over existing visitor tables at Carrieton
- Providing solar lighting to the visitor welcome sign at Carrieton

\$250,000 has been allocated for re-sheeting of roads. Local farmers and contractors will be used where possible for the project. The roads proposed for resheeting and rip and reform are listed in the table below.

A further \$8,000 will be spent on new and replacement tourism signage and \$17,000 on a picnic shelter and entrance wall solar lighting in Carrieton.

7.6 REMOVAL OF GUM TREE

Roots from the large gum tree on Fourth Street Orroroo adjacent to the Butchers Shop are causing the road verge, footpath and kerb to lift and crack. The floodwater grate near the tree has also lifted and is a trip hazard. After recent rain, most of the Fourth Street floodwater did not go down the grate due to it being higher than the surrounding asphalt. The floodwater instead flowed across Second Street.

Grant Reddaway (owner of the butchers shop) has informally raised concern about roots going into the foundations of the building and the leaf debris that constantly fills the shops guttering, however has also shared his belief that the gum is an iconic tree that has been there for a long time.

A quotation has been received to remove the tree including the stump at a total of \$3,200 ex GST.
